SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

1. DO NOT PLUG IN LAMP TO POWER BEFORE INSTALLATION IS COMPLETE.
 2. CAUTION- NEVER USE WITH AN EXTENSION CORD UNLESS PLUG CAN BE FULLY INSERTED. DO NOT ALTER THE PLUG. AC ONLY.
 3. INSTALL PROPER BULB TYPE AND WATTAGE.
 4. TO CLEAN THE FIXTURE, TURN OFF THE POWER, WAIT FOR IT TO COOL, AND WIPE THE FIXTURE WITH A CLEAN, SOFT CLOTH.
- NOTE: PRODUCT MAY NOT LOOK EXACTLY AS SHOWN IN FIGURES.**

INSTALLATION:

1. Pull the extra cord out of the base. Install the post to the base.
2. Remove one screw from the socket.
3. Attach the shade to the screws on the socket, turn the shade clockwise, and tighten the two screws.
4. Re-tighten the screw to secure the shade to the socket.
5. Install specified bulb type and wattage (not included).
6. Screw the glass shield on to the socket.

CAUTION:

• **Glass shield must be installed properly to avoid possible electrical hazard and safety issue.**

• **RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK. Do not use with extension cord near water or where water may accumulate. Keep lamp at least 16 feet from pools and spas. Keep plugs and receptacles dry.**

WARNING: When using outdoor use portable luminaires, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury, including the following ...

- a) Use only three-wire outdoor extension cords that have three-prong grounding plugs and grounding receptacles that accept the appliance's plug.
- b) Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) protection is to be provided on the circuit(s) or outlet(s) to be used for the wet location portable luminaire. Receptacles are available having built-in GFCI protection and are able to be used for this measure of safety.
