Installation Instructions

CAUTION: Turn off electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring fixture to the power supply.

Install the NPP-EM according to the instructions below. Do not place the NPP-EM where wireless signal transmission might be blocked, such as places close to metal plates or concrete walls. NPP-EM shall be placed close to other c-Max Network nodes of the same zone to guarantee mesh connections. Do not install near gas or electric heaters.

Do not use this product for other than intended use. Communicates only with c-Max Network controls. Contact MaxLite for a complete c-Max lighting controls layout when specifying UL924 devices. Placement of the UL924 device will be critical to guarantee mesh connections.

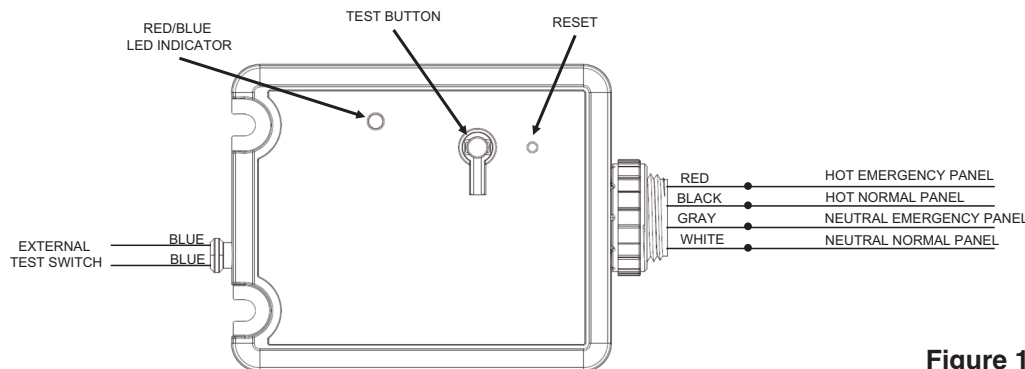

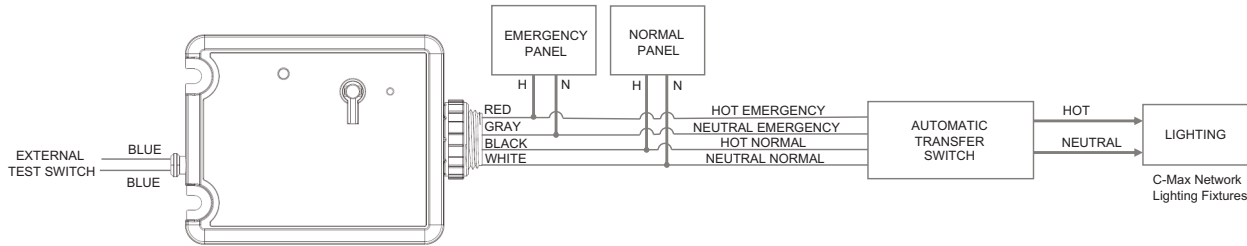
1. Connect the NPP-EM to the junction box or luminaire following the wiring diagram. (FIG. 1)

3. Refer to c-Max Guide for detailed instructions for commissioning.

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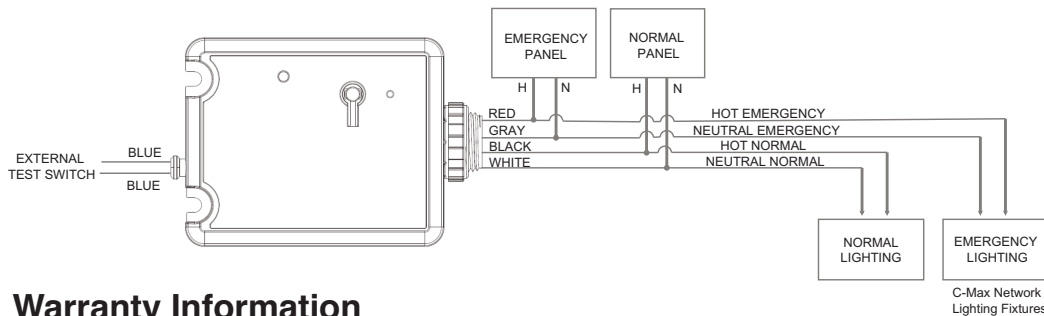
Typical Application
