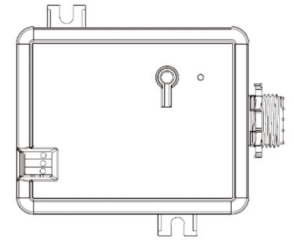

Installation Instructions

CAUTION: Turn off electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring fixture to the power supply.

1. Use the locking nut for mounting it externally to a junction box or luminaire. (**FIG. 1**)

Note: NPP-PL20A must be externally mounted to a junction box or luminaire.

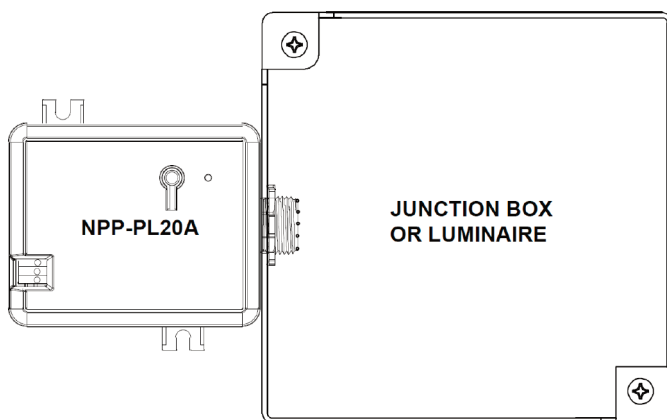


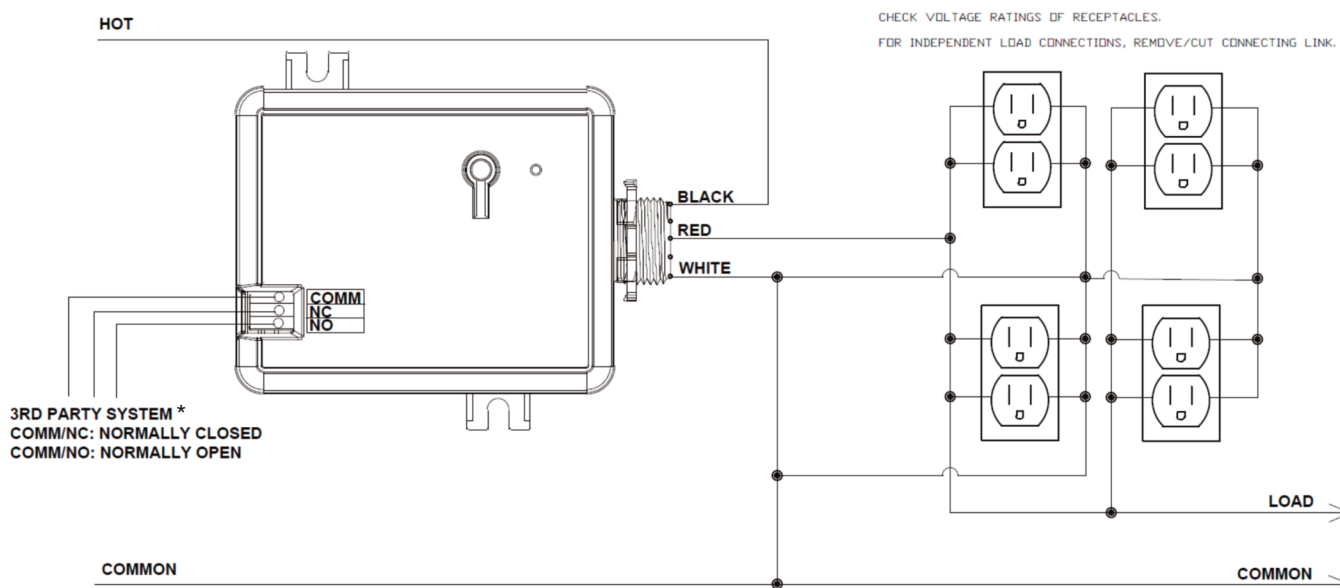

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**Installation Instructions (Continued)**

Note: Use LOAD and COMMON to add more luminaires to the circuit.
Install in accordance with all National and local Electrical codes.

2. Connect the NPP-PL20A to the junction box or luminaire following the wiring diagram. (**FIG. 2**)
