- Turn off the power when you perform any maintenance.
- Verify that supply voltage is correct by comparing it with the luminaire label information.
- Make all electrical and grounded connections in accordance with the National Electrical Code and any applicable local code requirements.
- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors.

- Wear gloves and safety glasses at all times when removing luminaire from carton, installing, servicing or performing maintenance.

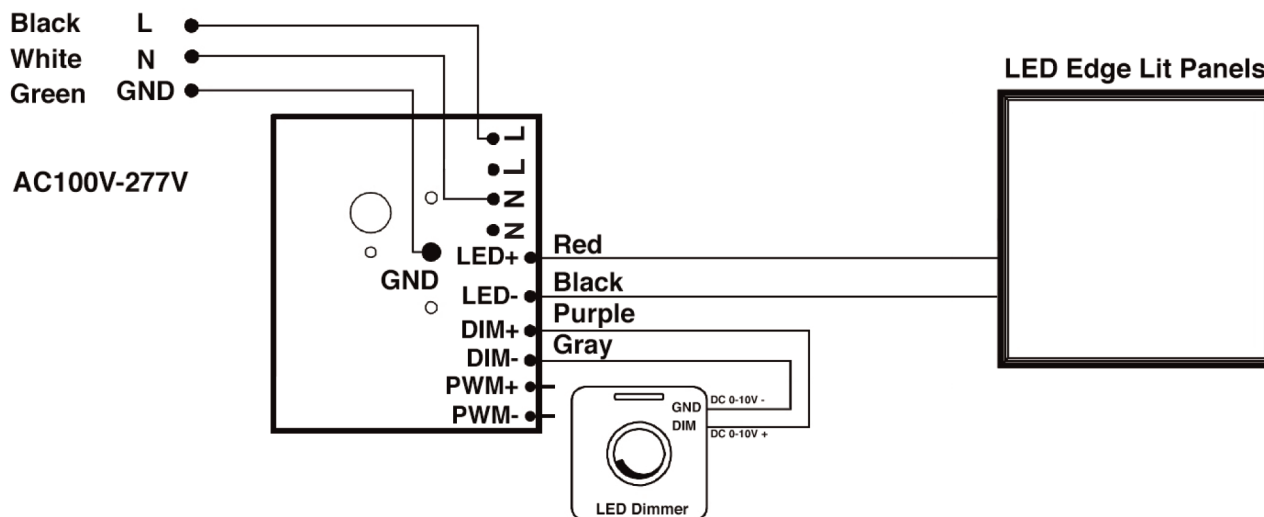
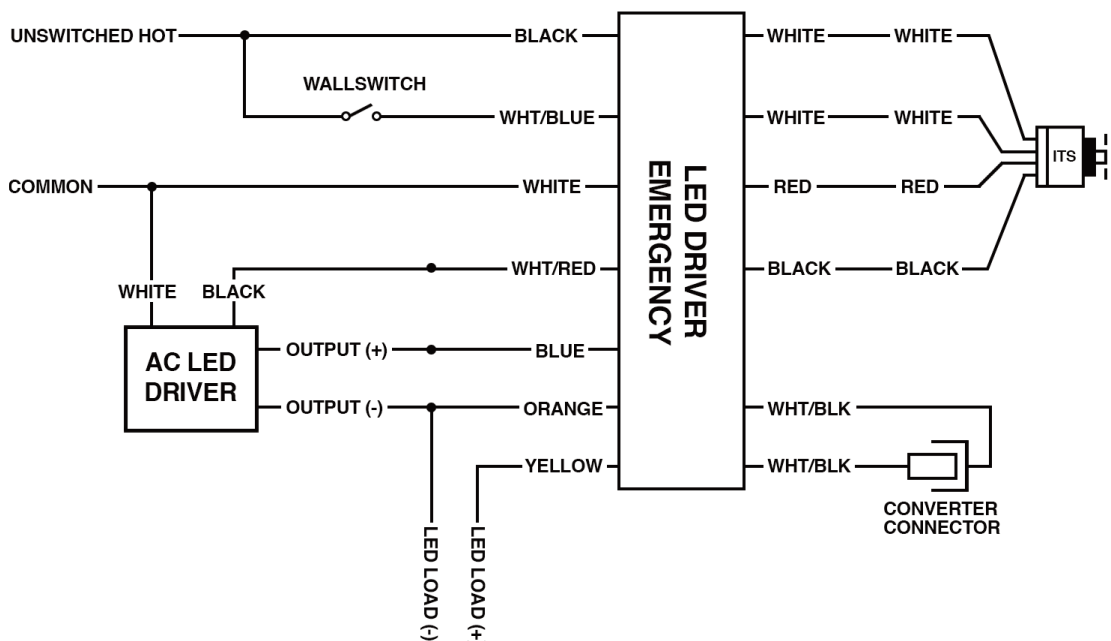

Selectable CCT

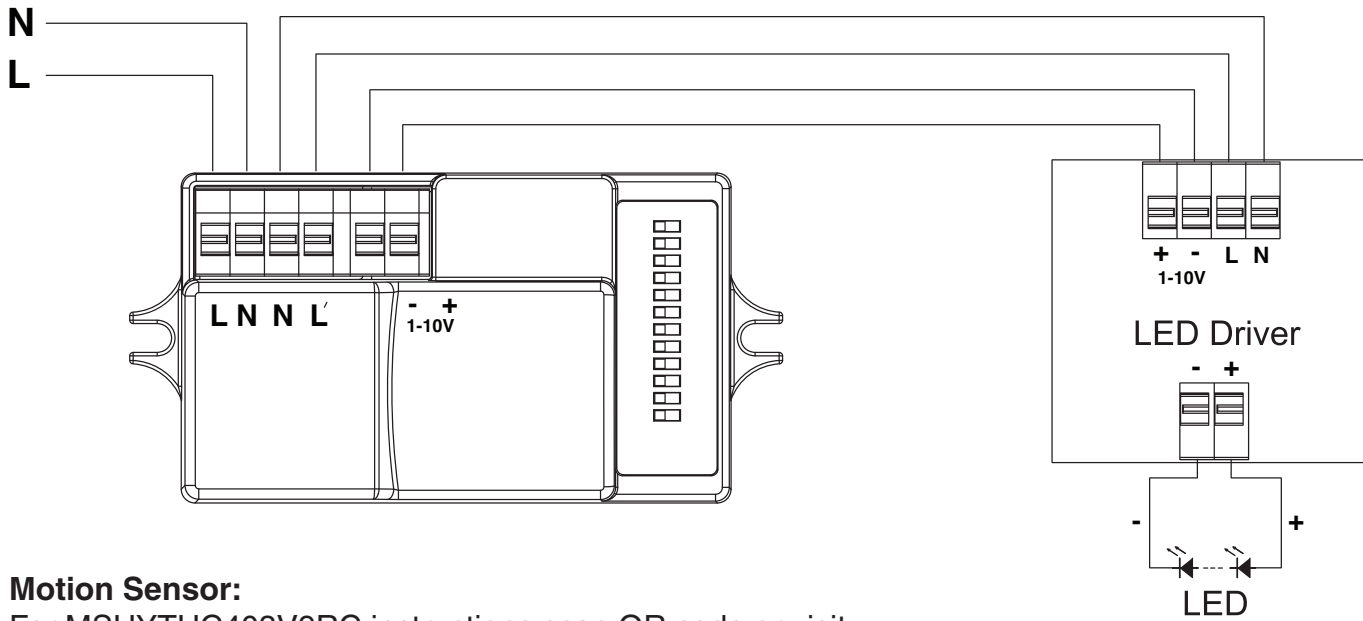
For models with selectable CCT: Open driver box and use the selector switch to choose your desired CCT. This should be done during wiring step.

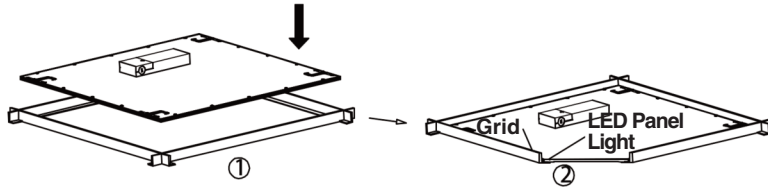

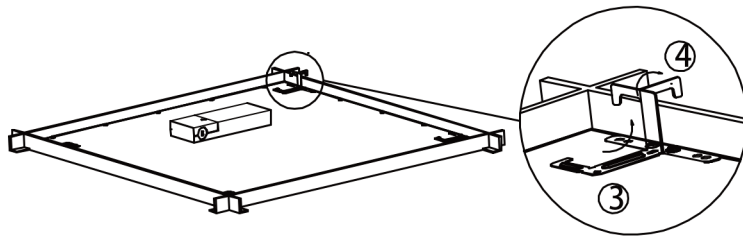
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Mounting Instructions

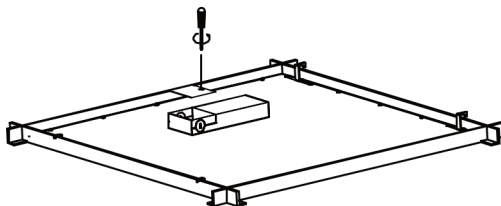
- 1.) Install LED Panel Light into grid (See **Figure 1** and **Figure 2**)



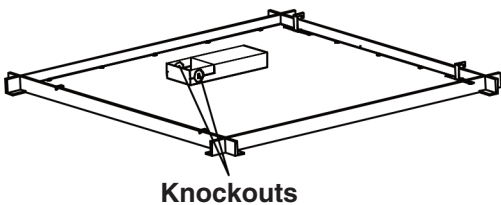
- 2.) Bend hang buckle by 90°, making it vertical to the rear cover of panel light (**Figure 3**). Bend hang buckle's top part by 90° (**Figure 4**), Same to all hang buckles. Buckles are only for positioning propose, it is not for mechanical securement.



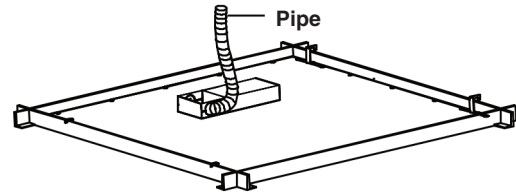
- 3.) Remove driver cover plate.



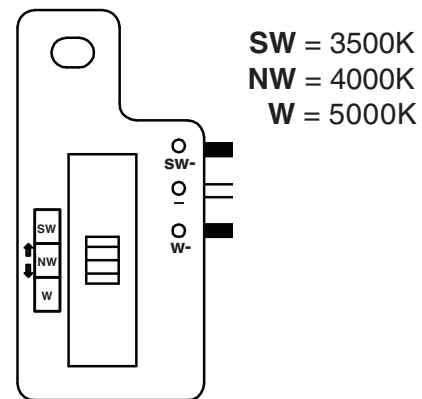
- 4.) Remove the knockouts.



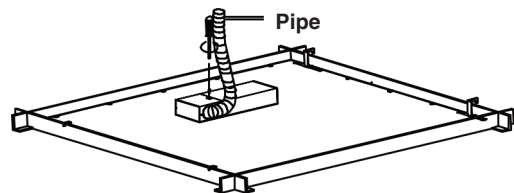
- 5.) Insert connector. Wire to fixture appropriately based on application requirements. See wiring diagrams on page 2 and 3. Reinstall the driver cover plate.



- 5b.) For selectable CCT models (CS) select the desired setting on switch before reattaching driver cover plate.



- 6.) Fixed driver cover plate. Power the troffer.

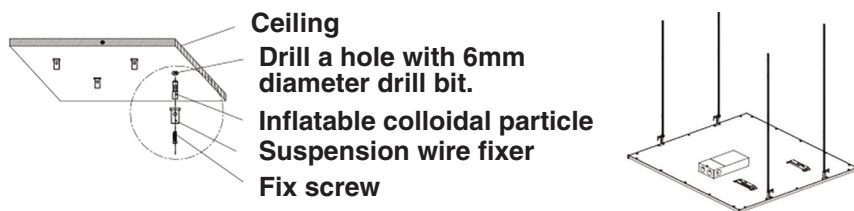


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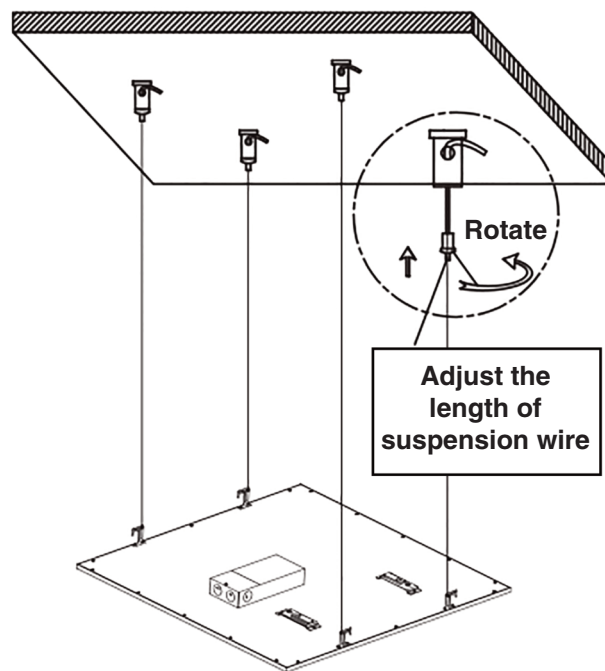


Optional Suspended Mounting

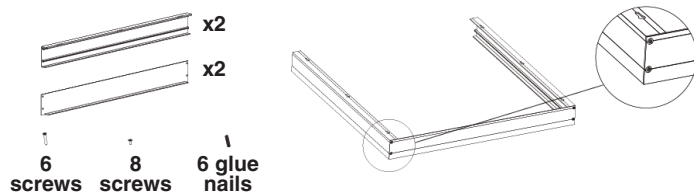


- 1.) Fix the suspension wire fixer on the ceiling

- 4.) Connect input wire



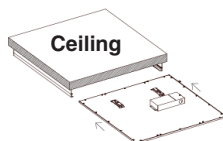
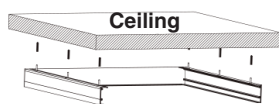
Optional Surface Mounting

(Kit sold separately)

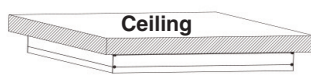
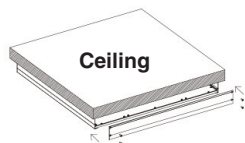


1.) Surface Mount Kits
